Rosé Wines

Grenache Rosé, Bellefontaine (Languedoc, France)

Be careful this is deliciously moreish. Juicy summer fruits with a crisp finish.

Pinot Grigio Rosé, Piattini (Lombardia, Italy)

An easy drinking fresh and dry blush with hints of strawberry and bramble aromas.

Côtes de Provence Rosé, Cuvée Des Lices, Ravoire et Fils (Provence, France)

Fresh strawberries and white peach flavours.

Sancerre Rosé, Domaine Daulny (Loire, France)

Crisp, refreshing and full of summer fruit flavours.

Red Wines

Garnacha, Shiraz & Monastrell Tinto, Murviedro Fauno (Spain)

Plums and blackberries lead the way here, with supple tannins and fresh juicy acidity.

Barbera, Alasia (Piemonte, Italy)

A great pasta red – fresh, juicy red with aromas of raspberries, plums and cherries.

Cinsault, Percheron (Western Cape, South Africa)

From gnarly 40-year-old bush vines, the wine is bright, expressive and gently savoury on the nose.

Shiraz, The Last Stand (Victoria, Australia)

This vintage is our brightest, most dangerously drinkable Shiraz to date due its fine, bright fruit and soft, silky elegance.

Merlot, Bellefontaine (Languedoc, France)

This Merlot has ripe red berry fruit aromas on the nose, which leads through to a rich, plummy palate.

Pinot Noir, El Viejo del Valle (Valle Central, Chile)

From cold, stony vineyards in old glacial riverbeds – barrel fermentation adds complexity, depth and warm vanilla notes.

Malbec, Pablo y Walter (Mendoza, Argentina)

Ripe blackcurrant fruit with savoury and spicy notes on the palate.

Primitivo, Convivale (Salento, Italy)

A richly flavoured red with aromas of plums, dried fruits and sweet spices – all balanced by a silky-smooth mouthfeel.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Showdown 'Man with the Ax' (California, USA)

After devastating wildfires, please help support our Californian winemakers – ripe blackcurrant and wild berry fruit on the nose complimented by sweet vanilla oak.

Garnacha, Honoro Vera (Calatyd, Spain)

Deep, smoky dark fruit gives way to soft, succulent tannins. Not one for the faint-hearted.

Côtes du Rhône, Guillaume Gonnet (Rhône, France)

Impressive forest floor sweetness, rounded out by peppery tannins.

Rioja Crianza, Ontañón (Rioja, Spain)

Bright ripe aromas of black fruit with hints of liquorice and mocha – very approachable, modern and satisfying Crianza

Crozes-Hermitage, 'Les Pierrelles' Domaine Albert Belle (Rhône, France)

Dark fruits, subtle spice combined with well-integrated wood.

Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Vallet Frères (Burgundy/France)

Balanced and elegant with peppery, strawberry fruit. Vallet Frères uses minimal intervention and organic practices.

St-Émilion Grand Cru, Clos de la Cure (Bordeaux, France)

A very classy St-Émilion Grand Cru – ripe and jammy with a delicious herbal finish.

Dessert Wines & Sherry

Torrentés, Tardio, Familia Zuccardi (Mendoza, Argentina)

Intense aromas of ripe peach, honey, pears and apricots.

Pedro Ximenez, Bodegas Gutiérrez, Colosia (Jerez, Spain)

Caramelised raisins and molasses, with an intense sweetness.
